

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF JOCELYN

BY-LAW NO. 1990 - 024



Being a By-Law to authorize the carrying on of a Community Program of Recreation within the meaning of the regulations under the Ministry of Tourism and Recreation Act, to provide for the operation, maintenance, and management of parks and to provide for the establishment, operation, and maintenance of Community Centres pursuant to the Community Centres Act and the regulations made thereunder.

1. The Council of the Corporation enacts as follows:
 - a) Pursuant to the Municipal Act, Chapter 284, Part XIX, Section 352/32 and Regulations made under the Ministry of Tourism and Recreation Act, a Community Program of Recreation is hereby established for the residents of the municipality.
 - b) The said Community Program of Recreation shall be directed, and managed, on behalf of the Council of the Corporation by a Committee known as the Township of Jocelyn Recreation Committee
2. The Township of Jocelyn Recreation Committee shall be appointed by the Municipal Council of the Township of Jocelyn and, shall consist of twelve members, two of whom shall be members of the Municipal Council, ten members of the community appointed for a term of one year.
3. The appointments of the Township of Jocelyn Recreation Committee shall be made annually at the first meeting of the Municipal Council of the Township of Jocelyn or as soon thereafter as is expedient. The members shall hold office during the pleasure of the Municipal Council of the Township of Jocelyn.
4. DUTIES OF THE RECREATION COMMITTEE
 - A) The COMMITTEE shall conduct or encourage and assist the programs of recreation which will meet the needs and interest of the inhabitants of the Township of Jocelyn. Such programs shall include the social, cultural, and physical aspects of recreation as applied to each group, both male and female.
 - B) The COMMITTEE shall assist in the coordination of community recreation activities.
 - C) The COMMITTEE shall assist, encourage and provide advisory services on request to all groups, organizations, or persons carrying on recreation activities in the Township of Jocelyn.
 - D) The COMMITTEE shall at all times keep the inhabitants of the Township of Jocelyn aware of the recreation opportunities which are available, and shall continually interpret to the public the total community program of recreation.
 - E) The COMMITTEE shall have the power to adopt rules and regulations pertaining to the proper conduct of the community program of recreation, and shall be responsible for the policy and administration of the community program of recreation conducted directly by the Committee.

- F) The Committee may recommend to the Municipal Council of the Township of Jocelyn the appointment of a Director of Recreation.
 - G) The COMMITTEE may recommend the appointment of recreation workers, either part-time or full-time, and shall be responsible for assigning the duties and responsibilities of such employees.
 - H) The COMMITTEE is empowered to work jointly with other Municipal departments to establish and conduct a supervised system of recreation.
 - I) As directed from time to time by the Municipal Council of the Township of Jocelyn, the COMMITTEE is empowered to operate, improve, and maintain property for parks, playgrounds, recreation centres, and other recreation facilities
 - J) The COMMITTEE may solicit or receive any gifts or bequests of money or services or any donations to be applied, principal or income, for either the temporary or permanent use of facilities, equipment, program or other recreational purposes.
 - K) Annually, the COMMITTEE shall submit and interpret to the Municipal Council, of the Township of Jocelyn, a budget for its approval and shall make to the Municipal Council full and complete reports as required.
 - L) In Carrying out the provisions of the by-law, the COMMITTEE shall at all times be the agent of the Municipal Council of the Township of Jocelyn and while acting bonafide within limits of the authority of this by-law, neither the COMMITTEE nor any member thereof shall incur any liability by reasons anything done or left undone by the COMMITTEE, provided however, that nothing in this paragraph shall empower the COMMITTEE to incur any debt, liability or obligation for which the Municipal Council of the Township of Jocelyn shall become liable, without having previously obtained the written consent of the Municipal Council.
5. By-Law No. 739 is hereby rescinded.
6. This By-Law shall come into force on passing.
