Subject: Purchase of used flail mower for Tractor

Recommendation:

That Council receives this report for information and authorizes the procurement and purchase of a used flail mower at a price of no more than \$32,500 plus applicable taxes and freight.

Background

At the June 3rd Council meeting, Council approved the purchase of a used flail mower attachment for the newly purchased Kubota Tractor at a price of \$24,500 plus freight and HST. Since the approval of the purchase, the mower was unfortunately sold to another buyer.

Since this unit has been sold, other units are available across the province at various prices, age and condition. However, most are at a price higher than 24,500 as they are newer units.

Given there is still a need for a flail mower, the Treasurer and PWF are recommending that Council authorize staff to procure and purchase a flail mower no more than \$32,500 plus freight and shipping.

BY_LAW No. 2026-XXXX

Being a by-law to confirm the proceedings of the Council of Township of Jocelyn at its meeting on the 24th day of June, 2026.

Whereas Subsection 3 of Section 5 of the Municipal Act, SO 2001, c. 5, provides that municipal powers, including a municipality's capacity, rights, powers and privileges under Section 9, shall be exercised by by-law unless the municipality is specifically authorized to do otherwise.

And whereas it is deemed expedient and desirable that the proceedings of the Council at its meeting on June 24, 2026, be confirmed and adopted by by-law.

Now therefore, the Council of The Corporation of The Township of Jocelyn hereby Enacts as follows:

1. That the actions of the Council at its meeting held on the **24th day of June, 2026**, in respect of each motion, resolution and other action passed, and taken by the Council at its meeting, is hereby adopted, ratified and confirmed as if all such proceedings were expressly embodied in this Bylaw; and
2. That the Head of the Council and the proper Officers of the Corporation of the Township of Jocelyn are hereby authorized and directed to do all things necessary to give effect to the said action or to obtain approvals where required, and, except where otherwise provided, the Chair and the Clerk are hereby directed to execute all documents necessary in that behalf, and to affix the Corporate Seal of the Corporation of the Township of Jocelyn to all such documents.
3. This By-law shall come into force and effect on the date of final passing thereof.
